General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will maintain settled conditions across most northern parts of the United Kingdom during Tuesday, although a weather front will spread some outbreaks of rain northwards across England and Wales.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 at first near Cape Wrath, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough to west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight.

Showers in north.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming easterly or southeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Moderate to west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight.

Rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Fog patches, rain later in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming south 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fog patches at first, rain for a time later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 2 or 3, occasionally 4 at first.

Slight.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first, then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then veering southwesterly later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east, becoming variable 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less at first in west, otherwise southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming southwest 4 or 5, then backing south 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near the Isles of Scilly.

Fair then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming southwest 3 or 4, then backing south 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate in west.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming south or southwest 3 or 4, then backing southeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in far south.

Fair then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first, becoming south or southeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly, backing northeasterly in north, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in northwest.

Fog patches at first, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast backing northeast, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fog patches at first, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast backing southwest, then backing southeast later, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Rain later in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first, becoming south or southeast 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in north.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

South backing east or northeast, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 for a time.

Slight.

Fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast, veering southeast later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less.

Moderate or rough at first in north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming east or southeast, 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or drizzle at times, mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming east or southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain or drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming east or southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Tuesday 03 Nov 2015 at 0600 UTC until Tuesday 03 Nov 2015 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Various weak troughs move over Shetland area from the west, with ridge building

into western waters later Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first in southeast, veering northwesterly 3 or 4 in northwest.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in shelter east of Shetland.

Rain or drizzle, occasionally mist.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 03 Nov until 0600 UTC on Wednesday 04 Nov:

Northwesterly at first in northwest and southwesterly in southeast, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate, but rough at first in west and slight later in shelter east of Shetland.

Rain or drizzle, mist.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to southeast 4 to 5, locally 6 at first, decreasing 3 to 4 in the afternoon, perhaps locally 5 in the evening, veering southwest later.

Slight, locally moderate this morning.

Isolated showers, perhaps locally heavy from this evening.

Good, occasionally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 2 to 4, backing south in the evening and increasing 4 to 5 overnight.

Slight locally moderate, with a low swell.

Isolated showers, perhaps locally heavy, dying out overnight.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor in showers.

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
