Forecast for Tuesday 01 Aug 2023

Weather: A cloudy but mainly dry day. Becoming a little brighter in the afternoon. Heavy rain arriving late evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 30% becoming 80% by afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Mainly good, occasionally poor in the morning with areas of fog on higher slopes above 600m. Cloud lifting and breaking through the afternoon. Poor at times in rain later.

Meteorologist's View

Strong summit early morning but soon easing. High UV levels despite cloud cover.

Forecast for Wednesday 02 Aug 2023

Weather: Spells of rain overnight and during the morning, perhaps heavy and persistent but low confidence for detail at this stage. Becoming drier in the afternoon as rain clears east.

Maximum wind: North or NE 20 to 30mph, gusts 45mph, easing through the afternoon.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 20% in morning becoming 70% in afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Poor visibility at times in the morning with extensive cloud above 600m. Becoming good in the afternoon as cloud and rain clear.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 13C rising to 17C.

At 700m: Plus 9C rising to 12C.

Freezing level: Above summits.
