General Situation

A ridge of high pressure over the British Isles brings a cool northwesterly flow which soon veers northeasterly in the south.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable for a time, then increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later north of Orkney.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough to the north of Orkney at first.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Firth of Forth.

Showers at first in north.

West 4 or 5, backing southwest 3 or 4 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers at first in north, rain later in north.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Occasional rain.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Mostly slight, but moderate swell for a time in far north.

Showers.

West 3 or 4, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Moderate.

Northwesterly 3 or 4, backing southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A showery northwesterly airstream covers Shetland waters

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Northwesterly, 3 or 4 in southwest, 5 or 6 in northeast.

Moderate, becoming rough in far north.

Showers

Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jul until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 03 Jul:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, but 3 or 4 at first in southwest.

Moderate, becoming rough except in sheltered waters southeast of Shetland.

Mainly good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North to northwest 2 to 4, veering north to northeast 3 to 4 by dawn, occasionally 5, mainly in the south of the area Tuesday afternoon, perhaps locally 6 in the far southeast, occasionally variable 1 to 3 mid-channel from midday.

Slight, perhaps locally moderate in the south of the area by midday.

Fair or fine.

Northeast, 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 by dawn, perhaps locally 6 from midday.

Slight, locally moderate from dawn, mainly in the southwest of the area.
