General Situation

Pressure will rise across the United Kingdom during the next 48 hours, although a strong northerly to northeasterly airflow will develop across southeast England on Saturday and a strong southwesterly airflow will also develop across northwestern Scotland during Sunday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, but west or northwest in Moray Firth, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate, but rough near Cape Wrath.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest backing south 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Cape Wrath.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near Cape Wrath.

Fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest veering northwest 3 or 4.

Moderate becoming slight.

Fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming northerly or northwesterly 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight, becoming moderate near Whitby.

Rain or showers, mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, backing north 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Showers, fog patches for a time, occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Moderate.

Occasional rain then mainly fair.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly backing northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight.

Occasional rain, fog patches for a time in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in north, increasing 7 at times in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, veering northerly or northeasterly 2 or 3, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight becoming moderate near Selsey Bill.

Fair at first then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at times in east.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in east.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional rain later in east.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor in east later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North veering northeast 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Fair in west, occasional rain or drizzle in east.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor in east.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near Isles of Scilly.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North veering northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 4 increasing 5, occasionally 6.

Rough at first in southwest, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers at first, otherwise fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North veering northeast 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 4, increasing 5, occasionally 6.
Slight, becoming moderate in st george's channel.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 5 or 6, veering northeast 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest 3 or 4, veering north or northwest 4 or 5.
Slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North 4 or 5 veering northeast 3 or 4.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Fair.
Good.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest veering north or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northwest 4, occasionally 5 becoming variable 2 or 3.
Slight becoming smooth or slight.
Fair.
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest veering west or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers then fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or northwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Mainly good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 2.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Fair.
Mainly good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, but 5, occasionally 6 at first in north.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.
Showers then fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly backing southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north, but becoming variable 2 in south.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.
Fair.
Good.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, fair later.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 4, increasing 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.
Moderate or rough.
Showers, fair later.
Good.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight near Sutherland.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will build from the southwest towards Shetland and the surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.
Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 05 Nov until 0000 UTC on Sunday 06 Nov:

West or southwest 3 or 4.
Moderate or rough.
Rain at first.
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming north 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5 by dawn and 5 or 6 by midday, locally 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate then rather rough or rough.

Isolated showers at first rain during the afternoon.

Good except in showers or rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North to northeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 to 6.

Rather rough or rough moderating a little.

Rain at times.

Good becoming moderate to poor in rain.
