#### General Situation

An area of high pressure and settled conditions in northern areas will give way to occasional heavy thundery showers already reaching southern areas. Fresher conditions will return to all parts during tomorrow with showers expected for many on Sunday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery rain and fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Thundery rain and fog patches at first, showers later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight, becoming moderate later.

Thundery rain and fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southeast 4 or 5 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Thundery rain and fog patches at first, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East, veering southwest later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight, becoming moderate for a time.

Thundery rain and fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 4 or 5 for a time later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north, becoming slight later in south.

Showers later.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate for a time.

Fog patches and thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight becoming smooth.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, veering westerly or southwesterly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 at times in south, otherwise variable 3 or less.

Slight becoming smooth.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly veering southwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 in west.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers and fog patches until later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Slight, becoming smooth for a time.

Fog patches developing later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East veering southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers and fog patches until later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East veering southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers and fog patches until later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East veering southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight becoming moderate.

Thundery rain and fog patches until later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming west or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly, veering southerly or southwesterly, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, occasionally 7 at first in far north.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery rain and fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7, veering south or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Thundery rain and fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.

Showers later.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, occasionally southeast, veering south or southwest later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers for a time.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, backing southeast for a time, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly, veering southerly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 at times, becoming variable 3 or 4 later in north.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later in north.

Thundery rain and fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 at times in north, otherwise southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in north.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming easterly 5 or 6, veering southerly 4 or 5 later, then becoming variable 3 or 4 except in far south.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate for a time in the North Channel.  
Thundery rain and fog patches for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers later.  
Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
East or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery rain and fog patches for a time.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 4 or 5 for a time.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers later.  
Good.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming easterly or southeasterly 5 to 7, veering southerly 4 or 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.  
Thundery rain and fog patches later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth.  
Thundery rain and fog patches at first in north, then showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in north.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or 4, becoming easterly or southeasterly 5 to 7, veering southerly 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery rain and fog patches later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery rain and fog patches at first in north, then showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in north.

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
High moving north across area late Fri, before passing into the Norwegian Basin on Sat as fronts approach from the south.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Variable 3 or less, becoming east 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Mist and fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Saturday 04 Jul until 1800 UTC on Saturday 04 Jul:

East or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight, becoming moderate.

Mist and fog patches. Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 to 5, occasionally 6, veering southwest by midnight, decreasing 3 to 4 during the morning, becoming variable or northwest 2 to 4 by the afternoon.

Slight to moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Isolated thundery showers and fog patches overnight, clearing Saturday morning.

Good, occasionally moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 1 to 3, occasionally 4 at first , becoming southwesterly 3 to 4 Sunday morning.

Slight with a low swell.

Mainly fair.

Good.

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
