Forecast for Monday 08 Apr 2024

Weather: Cloudy during the early hours with spells of rain moving northwards. Drier for a time through the morning ahead of further rain into the afternoon, becoming heavy at times and more persistent. Heavy showers breaking out into the evening which may contain hail. Winds lighter than the weekend, from a south to southeasterly direction.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 40%

Low cloud and visibility: Low cloud shrouding the hills for most by mid-afternoon, with some breaks possible first thing. Good visibility to start but moderate to poor visibility in persistent rain.

Meteorologist's View

Conditions may deteriorate quickly within heavy bursts or persistent rainfall leading to poor visibilities, low cloud and slippery surfaces underfoot.

Forecast for Tuesday 09 Apr 2024

Weather: A wet start with heavy rain, possibly sleet over the highest routes. Clearing by lunch time to leave a few blustery showers, these easing into the evening to leave sunnier spells and clear skies into the night. Strong northwesterly winds making it feel colder than of late.

Maximum wind: Northwesterly 30-35 mph gusting up to 50 mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 10% rising to 80% by the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Low cloud down to 600 m shrouding the hills through the morning. Poor to very poor visibilities in heavy rain, rising to good by the afternoon.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 6 Celsius rising to plus 11 Celsius.
At 600m: Plus 1 Celsius rising to 3 Celsius.
Freezing level: Rising above summits.
