General Situation

An area of high pressure to the north of Scotland will drift slowly westwards into the Atlantic as the area of low pressure to the southwest of the United Kingdom continues to move away.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

Northeasterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less for a time, then northwesterly 5 or 6 later near Mull of Galloway.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Weak trough will head over northeastern waters at first then high pressure builds across again early Wednesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwest veering west or northwest 2 or 3, occasionally 4 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional light rain in north.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Wednesday 02 May until 0000 UTC on Thursday 03 May:

West or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Channel Islands
