



National Severe Weather Warning Service



Chief Forecasters Assessment
 Following on from this morning's rain, further locally heavy rain will fall this afternoon. Whilst most places will miss the very heaviest rain, locally 15 to 20 mm of rain may fall in an hour and very locally 30 to 40 mm of rain could fall in two or three hours.
