Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

#### General Situation

A slack pressure gradient affects much of the United Kingdom with mist and fog on some coasts. Strong southeasterly winds affecting the northwest.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Fog patches, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5.

Fog patches, rain later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Mainly northeasterly 2 or 3.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Smooth or slight.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3.

Fair, fog patches later.

Good, occasionally moderate or very poor later.

Smooth or slight.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3.

Fair, fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west at first.

Rain or drizzle, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.  
Slight or moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:  
Southerly 4 or 5.  
Rain or drizzle, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.  
Slight or moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.  
Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches developing.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.  
Slight or moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 in northwest for a time.  
Rain or drizzle, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.  
Slight or moderate.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Good becoming moderate or poor.  
Moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.  
Slight or moderate.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel

24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 or 6, veering northwest 3 or 4.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.  
Moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 to 7, veering northwest 3 or 4 later.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.  
Moderate or rough.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides

24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 around Outer Hebrides, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Occasional rain, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.  
Moderate or rough.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7.

Occasional rain, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Moderate or rough.

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
