Forecast for Sunday 03 Jan 2021

Weather: The south and west dry with mainly clear skies and some sunny spells. A few snow showers over Sutherland and Ben Wyvis, possibly heavy overnight but light and scattered by day.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90% in southwest, 60% in northeast with some patches on the tops, mainly near showers.

Visibility: Generally very good, but poor in heavier snow showers in northeast these mainly in the early hours.

Note the very low feels like temperatures. Glen temperatures could be down to Minus 10 at night.

Forecast for Monday 04 Jan 2021

Weather: A dry day with good spells of sunshine.

Maximum wind: Northeasterly becoming northerly 10-15mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90% - mainly clear.

Visibility: Very good

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 5 to Minus 10, rising to Plus 2 at best during the day and staying below freezing where snow cover at low levels
At 800m: Minus 3 Celsius.
Freezing level: All levels.
