Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

#### General Situation

A slack pressure gradient affects much of the United Kingdom with mist and fog on some coasts. Strong southeasterly winds affecting the northwest from early Saturday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7.

Fog patches in east, rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate occasionally rough.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Isolated showers dying out, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in north.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north later.

Showers dying out, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 2 or 3 increasing 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north later.

Showers dying out, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast veering east 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Showers dying out, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Showers dying out, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Showers dying out, fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Slight occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in far west.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight or moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 in far west for a time.  
Occasional rain or drizzle in west later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight or moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in west.  
Rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight or moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 or 3 becoming southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in northwest.  
Rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight or moderate.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5.  
Rain later.  
Moderate or good.  
Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight or moderate.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Slight or moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor.  
Moderate or rough.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 around Outer Hebrides, decreasing 4 or 5 later.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.  
Moderate or rough.

Shetland Isles

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7.

Occasional rain, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor or very poor.

Moderate or rough.

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
