Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1800 UTC Monday 02 November to 1800 UTC Tuesday 03 November 2020

#### General Situation

A strong westerly flow will affect the British Isles on Monday night, with gales affecting many central and southern areas. The flow will veer northwesterly on Tuesday, with any gales confined to northern areas and far southeast England.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north, perhaps gale 8 later in north.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in north, slight or moderate in south.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly veering northwesterly, then backing southwesterly later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Rough or very rough in north, slight or moderate in south.

Squally showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 to 6, increasing 7 for a time in south.

Slight or moderate.

Squally showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest, backing southwest later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in shelter.

Showers.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Squally showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest, veering west later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Squally showers, rain for a time later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers fair.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic, then westerly later, 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough offshore.

Rain or squally showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, then veering northwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Showers at first.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 7 or gale 8, decreasing 5 or 6, but becoming cyclonic 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 5 or 6, veering northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4.

Moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, becoming cyclonic for a time, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Squally showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, veering north 3 or 4.

Moderate becoming slight.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8 for a time.

Rough or very rough west of Lizard Point, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate in shelter.

Squally showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, veering north or northwest 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate east of Lizard Point, otherwise rough or very rough becoming moderate or rough.  
Showers at first.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West, becoming cyclonic for a time, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times, veering northwest 4 to 6 later.  
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.  
Squally showers, rain for a time.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5, veering north or northeast 3 or 4.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate northeast of lundy.  
Showers, fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest gale 8 or severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7, then veering northwest 4 to 6 later.  
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough, then slight or moderate later in north.  
Squally showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers, fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest gale 8 or severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Rain or squally showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7, veering northwest 5 or 6, occasionally 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers, squally at first, fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, backing southwest 5 to 7, then veering west or northwest 5 or 6 later.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Showers at first.  
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.  
Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.  
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, veering northwest later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, backing west 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough in far north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
- (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, backing westerly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near the Mull of Kintyre.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West, mainly 4 at first, increasing 5 to 7, then veering northwest later.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough later.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 or 6, backing west 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Showers, fair later.

Good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough in far south, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West veering northwest, then backing southwest later, 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough in far north and in far south, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers at first, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 to 7.  
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough later.  
Rain or squally showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West veering northwest, then backing southwest later, 5 to 7.  
Rough or very rough.  
Showers at first, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Monday 02 Nov 2020 at 1800 UTC until Tuesday 03 Nov 2020 at 0600 UTC

## Shetland Isles

### General Situation

A showery westerly or southwesterly airstream affects Shetland Waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Gale now ceased but southwesterly gale force 8 expected later (issued 02/0959)

West 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first, backing southwesterly 5 to 7  
Rough, but moderate in well sheltered eastern waters  
Blustery showers  
Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Tuesday 03 Nov until 1800 UTC on Tuesday 03 Nov:  
Southwesterly, veering westerly or northwesterly later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north  
Rough, becoming very rough in north and west, but moderate in well sheltered eastern waters  
Blustery showers  
Mainly good

### Channel Islands - (SWW)

#### 24 hour forecast:

Westerly 6 to 7, perhaps locally gale 8 mid-channel at first, backing southwesterly 4 to 6 late evening, then southerly 6 to gale 8 after midnight with gusts to 50kt, veering west to northwest around dawn, perhaps briefly severe gale 9 in the north of the area, decreasing 5 to 7 by noon.  
Rough to very rough, decreasing moderate for a time tonight, increasing rough by morning, then decreasing rather rough in the afternoon a moderate swell throughout.  
Isolated showers, becoming more frequent and heavier overnight, with hail and a risk of thunder by dawn.  
Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly 5 to 7, veering northerly 3 to 4 overnight, then northeasterly on Wednesday morning, increasing 4 to 5 later.  
Moderate to rather rough decreasing slight by Wednesday morning, with a moderate swell throughout.  
Scattered showers, locally heavy with hail and a risk of thunder, becoming lighter and isolated overnight, then dying out on Wednesday morning.  
Good, occasionally moderate to poor.

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
