Forecast for Monday 03 Jul 2023

Weather: Mostly dry during the night with clear periods. Sunny spells on Monday with further showers breaking out during the morning. A few heavy afternoon showers with a very small risk of thunder.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 70%.

Low cloud and visibility: Generally very good visibility with occasional cloud above about 700m. Brief interruptions to poorer visibility as showers pass by and clouds lower down the hills.

Meteorologist's View

Forecast for Tuesday 04 Jul 2023

Weather: Mostly dry, bright start but showers again developing during the morning. Some of the showers will be heavy and possibly thundery in the afternoon.

Maximum wind: Light winds at all levels, westerly becoming northwest with average speeds about 10 to 15mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 70%.

Low cloud and visibility: Away from showers the visibility will be very good with occasional fog above about 700 to 800m. Patches of poor visibility as heavier showers come along with more extensive clouds lower down the hills.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 8 Celsius rising to 16 Celsius.

At 700m: Plus 9 Celsius.

Freezing level: Above the summits.
