Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0600 UTC to 0600 UTC

General Situation

A deepening area of low pressure will cross the United Kingdom today, moving out into the North Sea this evening.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, backing east 6 to gale 8 later, then becoming cyclonic.

Moderate becoming rough, occasionally very rough later.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming west or northwest 6 to gale 8, backing southeast later.

Rough occasionally very rough at first.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 7, backing easterly 7 or gale 8 later, then veering southwest.

Moderate becoming rough.

Rain.

Good becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 7 or gale 8, decreasing 5 to 7, backing south later.

Rough becoming moderate.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, veering southwest later.

Moderate becoming rough.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, veering west 5 or 6, backing south later occasionally 7.

Rough becoming moderate.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 or 6, backing southeast 7 or gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, veering southwest 5 to 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate, occasionally rough later.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, backing south later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8, veering southwesterly, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, veering westerly 5 to 7, backing southerly later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8, veering westerly 5 to 7.

Slight becoming moderate, occasionally rough later.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 5 to 7 increasing 7 or gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, veering west then northwest, decreasing 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest backing west 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 6 to gale 8, veering northwest occasionally severe gale 9 for a time.

Rough, but very rough in west.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 6 to gale 8, backing west 5 or 6, increasing 6 or 7 later perhaps gale 8.

Rough or very rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 6 to gale 8, veering northwest occasionally severe gale 9 for a time.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in west.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 6 to gale 8, backing west 5 or 6, increasing 6 or 7 later perhaps gale 8.

Rough, but very rough in west.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast, veering west or northwest 6 to gale 8.

Moderate, occasionally rough later.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 6 to gale 8, backing southwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 later perhaps gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8, veering west then northwest later.

Moderate, occasionally rough later.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 6 to gale 8, backing southwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 later perhaps gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, backing west or northwest 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8 occasionally severe gale 9 for a time.

Moderate becoming rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest backing southwest, 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 or 6, veering west 6 or 7 later.

Rough, occasionally moderate later.

Rain or showers.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8, veering northwest perhaps severe gale 9 later.

Moderate occasionally rough later.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 7 or gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9, backing west 5 to 7, backing southwest perhaps gale 8

later.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or squally showers.
Good becoming moderate or poor later.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8, veering northwest later perhaps severe gale 9.

Moderate becoming rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 7 or gale 8 perhaps severe gale 9, backing west 5 to 7.

Rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, becoming northwesterly 6 to gale 8 later perhaps severe gale 9.

Rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 7 or gale 8 perhaps severe gale 9, backing westerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Rough or very rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, veering northwesterly 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later in south.

Rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 6 to gale 8 perhaps severe gale 9 in south, backing westerly 5 or 6.

Rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, veering northwesterly 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later in south.

Moderate, occasionally rough in far north and far south.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 6 to gale 8 perhaps severe gale 9 in south, backing westerly 5 or 6.

Moderate, occasionally rough in far north and far south.

Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good occasionally poor.

The Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast to south 7 to gale 8, possibly severe gale 9 in the n at first,
veering west by midday,
decreasing 5 to 7 for a time late afternoon, veering nw by morning.

Rather rough or rough, locally very rough.

Rain or drizzle, locally heavy, clearing by midday to become fair, squally
showers developing by
evening with a risk of hail and thunder.

Moderate to poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest to west 5 to 7, backing southwest to west by evening.

Rough or very rough.

Fair periods and squally showers with a risk of hail and thunder, becoming
cloudy by Monday evening

with outbreaks of rain overnight.

Good except in rain or showers.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 01 Nov 2009 at 0600 UTC until Sunday 01 Nov 2009 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A developing depression will track northeast then north over the UK.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Easterly gale force 8
increasing severe gale force 9
later, issued 01/0335 UTC.

South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in the east, backing southeast 6 to gale 8.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers then rain, heavy at times.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good at first.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 01 Nov until 0600 UTC on Monday 02
Nov:

Southeast backing east 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time.

Rough or very rough.

Rain, heavy at times.

Moderate or poor.

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
