Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Sunday 04 October to 1800 UTC Monday 05 October 2020

General Situation

A deep and complex low currently centred over eastern England will drift slowly northeastwards into the North Sea through Monday and into Tuesday. This will bring unsettled conditions to all areas, with gales in southern waters.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 to 5.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly, becoming cyclonic in south, 3 to 5, occasionally 6 for a time near Orkney.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later near Orkney.

Showers, perhaps thundery later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast backing west, then southwest later, 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight in south.

Showers, perhaps thundery in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 3 to 5, becoming cyclonic 4 to 6 for a time.

Moderate, occasionally slight later in south.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North, backing west or southwest, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, becoming west later, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly backing southwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south and east, veering westerly or southwesterly 4 to 6.

Moderate or rough at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 for a time in south.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in east, veering westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in west.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, veering west or northwest 4 or 5, then increasing 6 or 7 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first.

Rain or showers, fair for a time.

Moderate, becoming good for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time in east.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high at first near the Isles of Scilly, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough in far southwest.

Showers, occasionally thundery.
Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first in southwest, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time in north.

Rough or very rough until later south of lundy, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North backing northwest, 4 or 5, then backing west 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough in south, slight or moderate in north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Moderate or rough in south, slight or moderate in north.

Rain at first in north, otherwise showers.

Moderate or good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly backing northwesterly, then westerly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 4 or 5, backing northwest 3 or 4, then west 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate.

Occasional rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest, backing west later, 3 to 5.
Moderate or rough until later west of Rathlin Island, otherwise slight,
occasionally moderate.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in far northwest.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in far northwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate in North Channel, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Firth of Clyde.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

North, becoming cyclonic later, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate in sheltered east, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming westerly or northwesterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in west.

Rain or showers, mainly in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Rain or drizzle, becoming mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming northwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming moderate later.

Rain or drizzle, becoming mainly fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming northwest 4 or 5 later.
Moderate, occasionally slight.
Showers.
Mainly good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Sunday 04 Oct 2020 at 1800 UTC until Monday 05 Oct 2020 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Large slow moving filling low, centered over the central UK, maintains an easterly flow.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Easterly or northeasterly, veering southeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in south

Mainly moderate

Rain, then mainly fair

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 05 Oct until 1800 UTC on Monday 05 Oct:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later

Mainly moderate

Mainly fair

Good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 6 to gale 8, with gusts to 50kt until midnight, decreasing 4 to 6, locally 7, for a time overnight.

Rough to very rough, with a low swell.

Rain, locally heavy, clearing to occasional showers during Monday afternoon.

Moderate to good, locally poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 5 to 7.

Rather rough to rough, with a low swell.

Occasional showers, perhaps heavy at times.

Moderate to good, perhaps locally poor at times.

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
