#### General Situation

An area of low pressure will move eastwards across northern England and out into the North Sea during this afternoon and evening. A brief ridge of high pressure will build across the United Kingdom on Sunday, before pressure falls again on Monday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, backing northeast 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South backing northeast 4 or 5, backing north or northwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight becoming moderate later.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, becoming south 4 or 5 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Rain at first and again later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, backing southeast then becoming cyclonic 5 or 6, becoming northwest 5 to 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 5 to 7, veering north 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later, then becoming southeast 4 or 5.

Moderate becoming slight later.

Rain at first and again later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good for a time.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, veering southwest 5 or 6, veering northwest later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 or 5 occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or less later,  
then becoming south 3 or 4.  
Moderate becoming slight later.  
Showers, occasional rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly veering westerly later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7  
for a time later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate.

Fair then occasional rain, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time, backing southerly or southwesterly 3  
or 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight later.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, veering westerly 5 or 6 later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Fair, then rain until later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly backing southerly for a time later, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 for a time.

Moderate becoming slight later.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, 5 or 6 occasionally 7 until later.

Moderate, occasionally rough for a time in west.

Fair, then rain until later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing south for a time, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 at first.

Moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 or 7, veering west 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough until later.

Occasional rain, fair later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing south 4 or 5, veering southwest later occasionally 6 for a time.

Moderate.

Fair then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west later, 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, decreasing  
4 or 5 later.

Rough, becoming moderate later.  
Rain for a time.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6, veering southwest 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate.  
Fair, then occasional rain.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, veering west 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough until later.  
Rain or showers, fair later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West backing southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6 later, then veering southwest 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair, then occasional rain.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast veering southwest, 5 to 7 occasionally gale 8 for a time, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time in south.  
Rain or showers, becoming fair later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwest backing south 4 or 5, backing southeast 5 or 6 later, then veering southwest 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair, then occasional rain.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in south, becoming westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4 occasionally 5 later.  
Slight, becoming moderate, occasionally rough for a time.  
Rain at first, then showers.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly or northwesterly backing southerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, increasing 4 or 5 for a time.  
Slight, occasionally moderate later.  
Rain and drizzle later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, becoming variable 3 or 4, becoming westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.  
Rain or showers, fair later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, becoming southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7 later, then veering southwesterly 4 or 5. Slight or moderate.  
Fair, then occasional rain.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, becoming variable 3 or 4, becoming westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.  
Rain or showers, fair later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, becoming southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7 later, then veering southwesterly 4 or 5. Smooth or slight.  
Fair, then occasional rain.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, becoming west 4 or 5 later.  
Rough, becoming moderate.  
Rain or showers, fair later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, becoming southeast 5 to 7 later, then veering southwest 4 or 5.  
Moderate, occasionally rough later.  
Rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain or showers, fair later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming south 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4.  
Rough, becoming moderate.  
Rain or showers, fair later.  
Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later, perhaps gale 8.  
Moderate, occasionally rough later.  
Rain later.  
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure covers Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

South or southwest backing southeast, 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northwest.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Sunday 04 Sep until 1200 UTC on Sunday 04 Sep:

Southeast backing east or northeast, 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair.  
good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 2 to 3 jersey southwards, 4 to 5 northwards, veering southwest this afternoon, increasing 4 to 6 by evening, locally 7 for a time in the north, veering west after midnight, decreasing 4 to 5 by dawn, locally 6 in the north. Slight to moderate, increasing moderate to rather rough this evening, locally rough for a time in the north.

Outbreaks of rain from late afternoon, perhaps locally heavy this evening, clearing by dawn.

Good, becoming moderate to poor for a time this evening.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 4 to 5, decreasing 2 to 4 by late afternoon, backing southerly by midnight, veering southwest 3 to 5 during Monday morning.

Moderate decreasing slight by evening, with a low swell, locally moderate in the north Monday morning.

Patchy light rain or drizzle from early evening.

Good becoming moderate overnight, locally poor.

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
