General Situation

A weakening cold front will continue its gradual progression southeastwards, and eventually lose its identity across southeast England later on Tuesday. To the rear of the front, a ridge of high pressure will build from the Atlantic.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to north 3 to 4, occasionally northwest 2 alderney northwards this afternoon, locally 5 jersey southwards late afternoon and early evening, becoming northeast or variable 1 to 3 jersey southwards by dawn, northeast 3 to 4 northwards.

Smooth or slight, locally moderate in the south early evening.

Risk of mist or fog patches near the french coast around dawn risk of a light shower Tuesday morning.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to very poor around dawn.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North to northeast 3 to 4, locally 5 jersey southwards late afternoon and early evening.

Smooth or slight, locally moderate in the south early evening, with a low swell.

Risk of a light shower on Wednesday.

Good, perhaps moderate in any showers.

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
