Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Sunday 03 June to 0600 UTC Monday 04 June 2018

General Situation

Slack mainly northeasterly pressure gradients will continue to affect the inshore waters of the United Kingdom during the next couple of days with thundery showers and sea fog continuing to affect many coasts. A weak cold front will move southwards through Scotland into central England on Monday, introducing cooler and fresher air.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northeast 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in north.
Fog banks, becoming fair later.
Moderate to very poor, becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in east.
Fair.
Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4 at times.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches, occasional rain or showers at first in south.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3 at first in west, otherwise northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.
Fog patches at first.
Moderate, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or showers until later, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.
Occasional rain or thundery showers and fog patches at first.
Moderate, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northwest 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or showers at first, fog banks.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.

Fog banks, becoming fair.
Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks.

Moderate to very poor, occasionally good at first in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.

Fog banks, becoming fair later.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, becoming variable at times in east, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in south.

Smooth or slight, but mainly moderate in west and at times in far south.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Thundery showers or fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly, becoming variable at times in east, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in south.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Thundery showers or fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming mainly north or northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, occasional rain or showers, mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in north.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, thundery showers for a time, mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming northeast later, 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor, or very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southeast 3 or 4 for a time, then occasionally north 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or showers at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northeast 3 or 4 at times, veering east 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, thundery showers at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southerly 3 or 4 for a time mainly in North Channel.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first, thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 3 or 4 at times in north, occasionally southeasterly 3 or 4 in south.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far northwest.

Occasional rain at first, or thundery showers for a time near shore, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4 at times, then becoming southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Fog patches at first, thundery showers for a time near shore.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in far south.

Thundery showers for a time, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly, veering easterly later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times, then occasionally 6 in north.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north and at first in far south.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches, occasional rain or showers at first in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly, veering easterly later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times, then occasionally 6 in north.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 03 Jun 2018 at 0600 UTC until Sunday 03 Jun 2018 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will cover Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

West or northwest 3 or 4

Slight

Mist and fog clearing. Becoming mainly fair.

Poor or very poor becoming mostly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 03 Jun until 0600 UTC on Monday 04 Jun:

West or northwest 3 or 4 veering north or northeast 4 or 5

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair. Mist patches.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 3 to 4, occasionally 5, increasing 4 to 6 by late afternoon, decreasing 3 to 4 for a time overnight.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Isolated thundery showers, especially near the french coast mist or fog patches in the north of the area overnight.

Good, locally moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 to 5, perhaps locally 6.

Slight to moderate, perhaps locally rather rough, with a low swell.

Mist or fog patches risk of thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate to very poor.

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
