Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Monday 03 November to 0600 UTC Tuesday 04 November 2014

General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will sink southeastwards, crossing the United Kingdom during today and tonight. This low will gradually move away eastwards during Tuesday leaving a cool northerly airflow across most areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly becoming cyclonic, then northeasterly later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times, but increasing 6 or 7 later in far north.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in north.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 3 or 4 at first in east, otherwise 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Slight at first in east, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or showers, thundery at first.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming north or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, and very rough in north.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 6, decreasing 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Slight, becoming rough later.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest becoming variable 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.

Slight, becoming moderate later in north.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight later.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Mainly southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Slight, occasionally moderate near North Foreland.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, decreasing 4 or 5.
Rough or very rough, becoming mainly moderate later.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly veering northwesterly later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.
Mainly moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.
Moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest veering northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.
Thundery showers, fair later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest, veering northwest later, 5 or 6.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far west.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate, except in west.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest, veering northwest later, 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far southwest.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest veering north later, 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 to 7 veering northwest 5 or 6 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest veering north 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough in south, otherwise slight or moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 to 7, veering west, then becoming cyclonic later, 4 or 5.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight later.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming north or northwest 5 to 7.
Slight becoming moderate.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 or 6, increasing 6 or 7, veering west or northwest 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 5 or 6 later.
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic becoming north 5 or 6, veering north or northeast 4 or 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic, then northerly later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in southeast.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, except in southeast.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly, becoming cyclonic, then northerly later, 5 or 6,

occasionally 7 at first in far south.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time in North Channel.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in North Channel.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South becoming cyclonic, then north later, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 for a time.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time in west.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast backing northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough in far north and in far south.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.
Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time in north.
Rain or showers, thundery at first.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southeast 3 or 4, backing northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough later.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough later.
Rain or showers, thundery at first.
Good, occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Monday 03 Nov 2014 at 0600 UTC until Monday 03 Nov 2014 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Southwesterly flow over Shetland waters eases Monday morning as complex Atlantic low approaches West Scotland, extending a trough over Shetland water in the afternoon.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

South backing northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 03 Nov until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 04 Nov:

Northeast 4 or 5 increasing 6 to gale 8.
Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest to west 6 to 7, occasionally gale 8, decreasing 5 to 6 during the morning, then 4 to 5 in the evening gusty near showers.
Rather rough to rough, decreasing moderate to rather rough in the afternoon.
Rain, locally heavy, clearing mid-morning, then scattered showers with a risk of thunder.
Good, locally poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 4 to 5 and gusty near showers, very soon veering northwest.
Moderate to rather rough with a swell.
Scattered showers, with a risk of thunder.
Good, locally poor in showers.

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
