### Forecast for Tuesday 09 Mar 2021

**Weather:** Extensive low cloud and some patchy light rain, or higher summit snow, at first. Becoming dry mid-morning with low cloud mostly clearing from the west through the morning to allow some hazy sunshine. Low cloud, summit severe gales and wet weather will return from the west from mid-afternoon onwards, although the east of the area may see only a little rain. Some wet snow possible on the very highest tops.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 50%

**Visibility:** Widely poor at first in cloud down to 300 metres. This cloud mostly lifting off summits but some patchy cloud down to 500 metres may linger across the western slopes of the Cuillins. Widespread low cloud between 400 and 600 metres returning from the southwest from mid-afternoon onwards leading to navigational issues.

**Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View**

Higher summit gales developing through the afternoon with storm force winds expected by evening.

**Forecast for Wednesday 10 Mar 2021**

**Weather:** Chance of a few snow showers in the morning in the north, otherwise mainly dry and bright. Thickening cloud will bring widespread rain, preceded by snow above 800 metres, from the southwest through the afternoon. Turning drier and somewhat clearer after dark, but still with some outbreaks of rain, and snow above 800 metres.

**Maximum wind:** Southerly gales on summits with gusts of 50 to 70 mph

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 50%. Best chance in the morning.

**Visibility:** Good in the morning, but becoming poor in rain and extensive low cloud between 500 and 800 metres in the afternoon, although this breaking up in the evening.

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Plus 2 rising to 9 Celsius

**At 800m:** Minus 1 rising to plus 3 Celsius

**Freezing level:** 600 metres, rising above summits in the afternoon, dropping back to 1000 metres in the evening
