Forecast for Monday 07 Jun 2021

Weather: Dry and clear overnight leading to some early morning sunshine. Cloud then thickening to bring the chance of a few heavy showers mid morning, before clearing by early afternoon. The rest of the day dry with cloud breaking to allow some sunshine at times.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90%, but falling 60% during the showery spell.

Visibility: Mostly very good, but moderate or poor in any heavier showers, when cloud bases may dip to 700m for a time.

Meteorologist's View

Forecast for Tuesday 08 Jun 2021

Weather: Early low cloud in southwest burning off then dry with sunny periods.

Maximum wind: Southwest 15 gusts 25mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 80% rising more than 95%.

Visibility: Very good, apart from early hill fog on the foothills in the morning, mostly 500-750m, and higher summits remaining clear.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 6 rising to Plus 20 Celsius.
At 800m: Plus 7 rising to Plus 11 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits.
