Forecast for Monday 08 May 2023

Weather: Cloudy with outbreaks of rain, some heavy, clear to patchy light rain towards dawn. This clears as the morning becomes drier and brighter for a time. Scattered showers, some heavy and thundery spread east from early afternoon.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 30% increasing 60% in the afternoon.

Low cloud and visibility: Moderate visibility will become poor to very poor at times in hill fog and extensive cloud to 400-600m at first. The cloud breaks lifting a little to 700-900m by the afternoon. The visibility drops moderate to poor in heavier showers.

Meteorologist's View

Early low cloud and hill fog will make navigation difficult in the early morning with showers and the possibility of lightning adding to this in the afternoon.

Forecast for Tuesday 09 May 2023

Weather: The morning will be dry with sunny periods. Showers bubble up from the early afternoon becoming heavy and thundery at times before dying during the evening.

Maximum wind: West 10-15mph

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 85%

Low cloud and visibility: The visibility will be good with patchy cloud at 1000-1200m, lowering 600-700m in showers.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 9 Celsius to 17 Celsius.

At 700m: Plus 7 Celsius.

Freezing level: Above summits.
