General Situation

High pressure to the north and a thundery low to the southwest of the United Kingdom will maintain an easterly or southeasterly airflow across most areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, veering south 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

East or southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 near headlands at first, decreasing 4 or 5 later, occasionally 6 near headlands.

Smooth in east, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally rough in west.

East or southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, decreasing 4 or 5.
Smooth in east, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally rough until later in

west.

Smooth in shelter, otherwise slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Southeasterly 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then northeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 3 to 4 in the south at first, otherwise 5 to 6, locally 7 in the north, decreasing 4 to 6 Tuesday morning.

Slight in the southeast at first, otherwise moderate to rather rough, locally rough in the north.

Scattered showers with a risk thunder, dying out Tuesday morning.

Moderate to good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to northeast 4 to 6, decreasing 3 to 4 by Wednesday morning and veering southeast later.

Moderate to rather rough, becoming slight to moderate on Wednesday.
