General Situation

A complex low across northern parts of the British Isles will slowly move away eastwards, with its associated frontal system clearing southern parts during Saturday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 occasionally 6 at first, veering northerly later.

Moderate or rough, but slight to moderate in Moray Firth.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 4 or 5.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West veering north or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, decreasing 3 for a time.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

The moderate to fresh westerly flow veers northerly, as a frontal trough moves south over Shetland waters around midday Friday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

West 5 occasional 6. veering northerly 4 or 5, occasional 6 in the east.
Rough.
Rain or showers, soon mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Friday 05 Nov until 0600 UTC on Saturday

06 Nov:

Northerly 4, occasional 5 in the east.

Rough.

Isolated rain shower.

Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 in the south of the area to 6 in the north, locally 7 mid-channel, veering northwest to north 4 around dawn.

Moderate in the south to rough in the north, becoming moderate in the north towards dawn.

Patchy light drizzle at first, especially in the north outbreaks of rain and drizzle overnight.

Mainly good becoming moderate to poor in rain or drizzle.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North to northwest 3 to 4, decreasing 2 to 3.

Moderate with a swell, becoming slight with a swell on Sunday.

Rain clearing during the morning, then isolated showers, dying out on Sunday.

Moderate to poor in rain becoming good except in showers.

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
