Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scattered rain, hail and snow showers across Scotland and Northern Ireland, most of the snow over higher ground, some showers heavy and prolonged across north and west Scotland at first. Becoming drier with longer sunny spells in the afternoon. England and Wales mainly dry with sunny periods apart from isolated wintry showers. Becoming dry and frosty overnight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday, milder weather will spread from the west with cloud and occasional rain, most of the rain in the west. Mainly dry and clearer for a time overnight before heavier rain and stronger winds spread from the west on Saturday.
