Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Northern and eastern parts should be dry with sunny spells. A few
showers continuing over the north of Scotland. It will become
increasingly cloudy over western parts with rain spreading across
north and west Wales into Northern-Ireland this afternoon and into
northern England and southern Scotland this evening. Feeling warm in
the sunshine. Some heavy rain over northern areas tonight although
the far north of Scotland should stay dry. Southern areas becoming
increasingly cloudy with mist and patchy drizzle over coasts and
hills.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Mostly dry and warm in southern parts. Windy with some heavy rain in
the north at first.
