#### General Situation

A slack but mainly cyclonic pressure pattern will dominate the United Kingdom during today, before pressure slowly rises across the south during Saturday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming mainly northeast later, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, thundery showers for a time in inner Moray Firth.

Moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, but extensive fog for a time, showers.

Moderate to very poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks becoming extensive fog at times.

Moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly north or northeast, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog banks.

Moderate to very poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming northwest later, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, thundery showers later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, thundery showers developing.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northwest 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times, becoming southwesterly 3 or 4 in south.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, thundery showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly southwesterly at first in south, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight.

Fog patches until later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then northeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in west.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, backing southerly in west, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in east.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then easterly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in west.

Fair then showers.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, backing south later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in Bristol Channel.

Slight.

Showers and fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then northeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight, becoming moderate later in west.

Showers later.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers at first, fog patches until later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming west or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time later in Solway Firth.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming south or southwest, 2 or 3.

Smooth.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southeasterly, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, but mainly southeasterly in North Channel, 3 or less, increasing 4 at

times.  
Smooth or slight.  
Thundery showers, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth or slight.  
Thundery showers at first, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth or slight.  
Thundery showers, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in west.  
Thundery showers at first, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

The Minch  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.  
Smooth or slight.  
Thundery showers in east, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northeast 4 or 5.  
Smooth or slight.  
Thundery showers at first in east, fog patches until later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Slight.  
Fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northeast 4 or 5.  
Slight, occasionally moderate later.  
Fog patches until later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A slack area of low pressure covers the area maintaining a moist airmass over Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Variable 3 or less

Slight

Misty with fog patches, but mainly fair in northeast

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, but mainly good in northeast

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Saturday 02 Jun until 1800 UTC on Saturday 02 Jun:

Variable 3 or less

Slight

Misty with fog patches, isolated showers, but mainly fair in northeast at first

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, but mainly good in northeast at first

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 2 to 4, becoming variable 1 to 3 around dawn then northeasterly by evening.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of mist patches overnight, clearing mid-morning.

Good, perhaps locally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 2 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 during the morning.

Smooth or slight occasionally moderate, with a low swell.

Risk of mist patches isolated showers Sunday morning.

Good, perhaps locally moderate to poor.

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
