Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
A band of cloud and showery rain will move towards the southeast today but becoming increasingly impotent as it does so. Brighter skies with a scattering of showers will follow to most other parts. Feeling warm though in mild southwesterly winds. Most places will become dry tonight, though rain will arrive in the southwest by morning.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain and strong winds in the southwest will quickly spread across much of the country on Saturday, though parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland could escape with just a few showers. Sunday will remain fairly breezy, and cloudy though many places will stay dry.
