General Situation

Showers will affect western and northern areas during the weekend, although most southern and southeastern parts should remain fair.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming easterly or northeasterly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 in northwest.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, occasionally 2 at first, increasing 6 at times later in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fair then thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming easterly or northeasterly, 3 or less, increasing 4 for a time in south.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later in south, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast, becoming cyclonic later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming southeast 2 to 4.

Slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 2 or 3 increasing 4 or 5, then veering southwest 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate for a time.

Fair then showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming southeast 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth in south.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time, then veering west or southwest 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate for a time in north.

Fair then showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly veering southeasterly, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly, veering southwesterly later, 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Fair then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly easterly 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 2 to 4 veering southwesterly 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers later.

Moderate or good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4 veering southwest 4 to 6.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast becoming variable, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in west.

Showers, mainly in west.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming southwest 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming south or southeast, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast veering southwest, 3 to 5, occasionally 2 at first,

increasing 6 at times later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate later.
Showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly southeast 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in south.
Fair then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering south or southwest, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, perhaps thundery later.
Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 1 or 2 for a time.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast veering south or southwest, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in northwest.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 1 or 2 for a time.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then showers.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering south or southwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.
Showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering south 3 to 5, then veering southwest 2 to 4 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later except in far north.
Showers, perhaps thundery.
Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 in Firth of Clyde.
Smooth or slight.
Fair then showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly, veering southerly later, 3 to 5, occasionally variable 2 in Firth of Clyde.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later in North Channel.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near the Mull of Kintyre, islay and Tiree, becoming variable 2 at times elsewhere.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later near Tiree.

Fair then showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 at times in shelter.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first near Tiree.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly northeast, becoming east later, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair then showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast, veering south later, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in far north, becoming variable 2 at times elsewhere.

Slight, occasionally moderate to the west of the Outer Hebrides.

Showers, mainly later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later in far north, becoming variable 2 at times elsewhere.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A weak ridge of high pressure extends southwards to lie to the west of Shetland, maintaining a northeasterly flow.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, locally variable 1 to 3, backing east or northeast by
late afternoon and increasing 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time
overnight, then west 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mist or fog patches, mainly near the french coast at first and later, isolated
showers.

Good, locally moderate in showers, and poor or very poor in mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, locally variable or northwesterly 1 to 3 in
the south of the area by midday, becoming southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5
overnight, perhaps locally 6 mid-channel.

Slight or smooth, becoming locally moderate in the north of the area overnight,
with a low swell developing.

Mist and fog patches, clearing in the afternoon, risk of patchy rain from mid-
morning to early afternoon.

Good, locally moderate in any rain, and poor or very poor in mist or fog.

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
