General Situation

A slack but mainly cyclonic pressure pattern will dominate the United Kingdom during today, before pressure slowly rises across the south during Saturday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, thundery showers for a time in inner Moray Firth.

Moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly northeast 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, but extensive fog for a time.

Moderate to very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks becoming extensive fog at times.

Moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly north or northeast, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog banks.

Moderate to very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 in north.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming northwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times, becoming southwesterly 3 or 4 later in south.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, thundery showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly southwesterly in south, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally smooth at first.

Fog banks until later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, but becoming good at times later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally smooth at first.

Fog banks at first.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, then becoming moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly, backing southerly in west, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east.

Slight, occasionally moderate near the Isles of Scilly.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then easterly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near the Isles of Scilly.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest, backing south later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in Bristol Channel.

Slight.

Thundery showers and fog patches until later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, but becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less, then northeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth in north.
Fair.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming west or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in Solway Firth.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in Solway Firth, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming south or southwest later, 2 or 3.

Smooth.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate to very poor, becoming good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southeasterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers for a time, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, but mainly southeasterly in North Channel, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers at first, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers for a time, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers at first, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.
Fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A slack area of low pressure covers the area maintaining a moist airmass over Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Variable 3 or less
Slight
Misty with fog patches, but mainly fair in northeast

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, but mainly good in northeast

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Saturday 02 Jun until 1200 UTC on Saturday 02 Jun:

Variable 3 or less

Slight

Misty with fog patches, some showers later, but mainly fair in northeast at first

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, but mainly good in northeast at first

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 3 to 5, locally northwest to north 2 to 4 near the brittany coast until early evening, becoming variable 1 to 3 Saturday morning.

Slight, locally moderate, becoming smooth or slight overnight.

Risk of a shower at first fog banks, clearing for a time this afternoon and evening.

Moderate to very poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest or variable 1 to 3, becoming north to northeast 2 to 4 by mid afternoon, veering easterly overnight, increasing 4 to 5 Sunday morning.

Smooth or slight, increasing slight to moderate Sunday morning, with a low swell.

Mist or fog patches.

Good, locally poor or very poor.
