Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Sunday 04 October to 1200 UTC Monday 05 October 2015

#### General Situation

A complex Atlantic low pressure system will move northeastwards, bringing unsettled and at times windy conditions to all areas by Monday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in north.

Smooth or slight for a time in east, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough and very rough later in northeast.

Fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in northeast.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times.

Moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly southwesterly, backing southerly or southeasterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west, veering southerly 4 or 5 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate.

Occasional rain later.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight, becoming moderate, occasionally rough.

Fair then occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south later, 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time in far west.

Fair then occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming cyclonic later, 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering south or southwest later, 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Fair then occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, becoming cyclonic later, 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate in east, otherwise moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7, then veering south later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Fair then occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, backing east 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, veering south later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate, and moderate or rough in north and west.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in northwest.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 6 to gale 8, then veering south or southwest later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough later.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, backing east 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later, then becoming cyclonic later.

Smooth or slight at first in east, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming south or southeast, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, backing easterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later, then becoming cyclonic later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate, then moderate or rough later. Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming southerly or southeasterly, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, backing east 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later in west.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, veering south or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in west.

Occasional rain or showers, thundery later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Smooth or slight in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain later in south.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 5 to 7, veering south or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth near skye, raasay and rona.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast backing east later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight near Sutherland, otherwise moderate.

Rain later in south.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 5 to 7, veering south or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near mingulay and berneray.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 04 Oct 2015 at 1200 UTC until Monday 05 Oct 2015 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will cover Shetland on Sunday. This will move away north on Monday as a complex low moves east into the UK.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Variable 3 or less becoming southeast 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate.  
Isolated showers at first.  
Mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 05 Oct until 1200 UTC on Monday 05 Oct:  
Southeast 3 or 4 increasing 5 or 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair.  
Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 6, locally 4 at first, increasing 6 to 7 by early evening, veering south around midnight and decreasing 5 to 6.  
Slight in the south, moderate in the north, increasing moderate to rather rough for a time overnight, perhaps rough mid-channel.  
Rain spreading from the south from late afternoon, clearing around midnight, then isolated showers.  
Moderate, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 4 to 5, occasionally 6, veering south to southwest later Tuesday morning.  
Slight in the south, moderate in the north, with a low swell.  
Showers becoming isolated Monday evening risk of thunder.  
Moderate, occasionally poor.

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
