Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0001 UTC to 2359 UTC

General Situation

An area of high pressure in the north Atlantic will sink southwards allowing a deepening low to run around the north to be centred near Iceland this afternoon. This low will then move southeast into the northern North Sea through tomorrow.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly becoming variable 3 or 4 then southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 later

then veering southwesterly, perhaps gale 8.

Slight or moderate becoming rough later west of Orkney.

Rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly veering northwesterly 5 to 7 increasing 7 to severe gale 9.

Slight or moderate but rough becoming very rough west of Orkney.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly backing southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable for a time in north, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 5 to 7 increasing 7 to severe gale 9, veering northwesterly later.

Mainly moderate.

Rain then squally showers.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

Northwest backing southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Southwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 for a time, veering northwest later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Rain or showers.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or 4 backing west 4 or 5, backing southwest 5 to 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate later.

Fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.

Mainly moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West backing southwest 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 later, perhaps gale 8.

Slight or moderate.

Fair then occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering west or northwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time.

Moderate becoming rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5 backing west 5 or 6, increasing 6 or 7 later, perhaps gale 8.

Slight or moderate.

Fair at first then occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West veering northwest 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 at times.

Moderate becoming rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 in north and later in south, perhaps gale 8.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in north.

Rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly veering northwesterly 5 to 7, increasing 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale

9 in north.

Moderate in south but rough becoming high in north.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the

North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, increasing 5 to 7 later, perhaps gale 8 in Firth of Clyde.

Slight or moderate becoming rough later around Mull of Kintyre.

Rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7 increasing 7 to severe gale 9 for a time, veering northwesterly later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough around Mull of Kintyre.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 then west 5 or 6, backing southwest 6 or 7 later, perhaps gale 8.

Moderate becoming rough later, occasionally very rough.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 or 7 increasing 7 to severe gale 9, perhaps storm 10 in north, veering northwesterly 7 or

gale 8 later.

Rough or very rough becoming high for a time.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4 becoming variable for a time, then increasing 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate becoming very rough later.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7 veering northwest 7 to severe gale 9, perhaps storm 10 for a time.

Very rough becoming high.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.
