Forecast for Saturday 04 Nov 2023

Weather: Mist patches soon lifting but becoming cloudy with outbreaks of rain arriving from the south in the morning and continuing on and off through the day. The rain may briefly turn heavy at times with a small chance of thunder.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 80% becoming 40% during the morning.

Low cloud and visibility: Mostly good visibility at first but becoming poor at times in rain with patchy cloud down to 500 or 600m.

Meteorologist's View

Feeling cold on the tops in the strong easterly breeze and outbreaks of rain.

Forecast for Sunday 05 Nov 2023

Weather: Showery rain dying out overnight, the odd mist patch developing. A largely dry day with sunny spells and the odd passing shower.

Maximum wind: West or Northwest 15 to 20mph, gusts 30mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 90%.

Low cloud and visibility: Generally good visibility but brief reductions in showers with patchy cloud above 600 or 700m.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 4C rising to 9 or 10C.
At 700m: Plus 4 or 5C.
Freezing level: Above summits.
