#### General Situation

The United Kingdom will remain under a slack airflow, although Atlantic fronts will bring some rain to many areas.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5 at first in east, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate in east.

Rain or thundery showers, fog patches in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming east or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate in east at first.

Showers, fog patches in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in east.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 in St Andrews Bay and the Firth of Forth, otherwise mainly southeast 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming mainly east or southeast 2 or 3.

Slight.

Showers, thundery at times, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5 decreasing 2 or 3, becoming variable later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Rain or thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming southeast 2 or 3.

Slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor for a time.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

Slight, occasionally moderate near Norfolk.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Easterly or southeasterly becoming variable 2 or 3.

Smooth or slight.

Showers then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Showers then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southwest 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4 later in far west.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming south or southwest 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain or showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3.

Slight.

Rain or showers, fog patches, becoming mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming south or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later in west.

Mainly fair then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly south or southwest 2 or 3.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, fog patches, becoming mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming south or southeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in south.

Mainly fair then rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, thundery at times, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming south or southeast later, 2 or 3, occasionally 4 later in west.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly south 2 or 3.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3 becoming southeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Showers then mainly fair, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally northwesterly 4 later in North Channel.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers then mainly fair, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.  
Mainly fair.  
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northwest 3 or 4 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, fog patches at first in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure in the Atlantic will push associated fronts east or northeast across Scotland and Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 02 Aug until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 03 Aug:  
Southeast 4 or 5.  
Moderate.  
Rain or showers, fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast to east 1 to 3, locally 4 in the afternoon.  
Smooth or slight.  
Risk of showers in the southeast in the evening some sea fog patches.  
Mainly moderate, locally very poor in fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeast to east 1 to 3, locally variable, becoming northwest Wednesday morning and southwest in the afternoon, increasing 3 to 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Some sea fog patches becoming cloudy in the afternoon, risk of rain or drizzle later.  
Moderate, locally poor or very poor in fog.

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
