Forecast for Sunday 07 Mar 2021

Weather: Cloudy with patchy rain and snow overnight. It will remain cloudy and mostly overcast during daylight hours with outbreaks of rain and summit snow, sleet and snow mainly above 1000m. The odd heavier burst expected, particularly later in the day. It will also be windy at height with a significant wind chill.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30%.

Visibility: Mostly good or very good lower down, but moderate at times in rain. Poor or very poor at times at height with extensive cloud, base 600 to 900m.

Weather: Mostly cloudy with occasional rain and summit snow. Some drier spells.

Maximum wind: West or Southwest 10 to 20mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 40%

Visibility: Often good or very good lower down, but moderate or poor in rain. Poor or very poor at times at height with extensive cloud, base 600 to 900m.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 2 Celsius rising to 8 Celsius
At 800m: Around 2 Celsius
Freezing level: Around 1000m
