Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be windy for many and cold in the north with heavy rain pushing
northeastwards. This will become slow moving across Scotland where some snow is
likely over the hills, and to low levels later in the west. Sunny spells and
showers will spread across central and southern parts. Frost and ice will form
under clear spells tonight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

The wind, rain and hill snow in the northeast on Friday will gradually ease.
Elsewhere it'll be breezy with sunny spells and showers. The breezy and showery
theme will continue into the weekend, with some hill snow in the north.
