General Situation

Low pressure centred over the northern North Sea will move slowly
southeastwards, bringing an unstable northerly airflow with strong to gale-force
winds to all areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 6 to gale 8.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in shelter.

Squally showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North veering northeast 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time in Moray
Firth.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate in west.

Squally wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 6 to gale 8.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate near shore.

Squally showers.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in northeast.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

Northerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, becoming moderate in far east.

Rain for a time in east.

Good, occasionally moderate at first in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 to 7, veering northerly 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough later in far east.

Squally showers.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 4 or 5, veering north 5 or 6, increasing 6 at times later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4, veering northerly 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times in west.

Slight, occasionally moderate in east, moderate, occasionally rough in west.

Showers, squally later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times in east.

Rough in far west, otherwise slight or moderate.

Squally showers.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5 veering northerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough in far west.

Showers, becoming squally later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly, veering northeasterly later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in west,

decreasing 4 at times in the Bristol Channel.
Rough in far west, otherwise slight or moderate.
Squally showers.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 4 or 5 at first in south, otherwise north 5 to 7.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough in north and west.
Showers, becoming squally.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northerly 5 to 7, veering northeasterly 4 or 5 later.
Rough until later in north and west, otherwise moderate, occasionally slight.
Squally showers.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North 5 to 7.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time near great orme head.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
North, occasionally northeast later, 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough near great orme head.
Showers later.
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North or northwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.
Moderate, occasionally rough.
Showers.
Good.

North 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
North 5 to 7.
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.
Squally showers.
Good.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

The Minch - (SWW)

Northerly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in north.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

With low pressure over the North Sea, the area remains under the influence of a cold strong unstable north- or northeasterly airflow.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Northeasterly gale force 8 expected later. Issued at 21:34 on 3 November 2016.

North or northeast 6 to gale 8.
Rough or very rough.
Squally wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 05 Nov until 0000 UTC on Sunday 06 Nov:

North or northeast 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 later in far east.

Rough or very rough.

Squally wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to north 4 to 5, occasionally 6, decreasing mainly 4 by dawn, increasing 4 to 5 by midday, occasionally 6 with gusts to 35 knots near showers.

Moderate, locally rather rough, decreasing slight to moderate for a time

Saturday morning.

Scattered showers risk of hail and thunder especially around midday and late evening.

Good, moderate to poor in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 4 to 6 with gusts to 40 knots near showers.
