Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure builds over northern areas of the United Kingdom. Pressure remains low over western France.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north at first, becoming variable then southeasterly later, 3 or 4.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Slight or moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming mainly easterly later, 3 or 4.

Occasional rain or drizzle later.

Good becoming moderate or poor.

Slight.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Slight or moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 or 6 veering east or southeast 3 or 4.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Good becoming moderate or poor.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 5 or 6 decreasing 3 or 4.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor later.

Slight or moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7 decreasing 3 or 4.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Slight or moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7, veering east 4 or 5 later.

Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel
24 hour forecast:
Northeast 5 or 6, veering east 4 or 5 later.
Occasional rain or drizzle later.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in southwest at first.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in far south at first.
Occasional rain or drizzle later.
Moderate or good.
Slight or moderate.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 or 5.
Occasional rain or drizzle later.
Moderate or good.
Slight, occasionally moderate in southwest.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
North or northeast, veering east or northeast later, 3 or 4.
Fair.
Good.
Slight.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5 later.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.
Mainly slight.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde
and the North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or northeast 4 or 5 later.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.
Slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or southeast 4 or 5 later.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.
Slight or moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, veering
northeasterly, then southerly or southeasterly later, 3 or 4.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.
Slight or moderate, but rough in north at first.

Shetland Isles
24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6 veering north, then southeast later, 3 or 4.
Rain dying out.
Moderate or good.
Moderate or rough decreasing slight or moderate.
