Forecast for Friday 05 Nov 2021

Weather: Cloud thickening to bring patchy rain and drizzle soon overnight, mainly focused across western ranges. Rather cloudy through the day and evening, with occasional showers, these mostly light, also most frequent early morning and early afternoon. Best chance of the limited brighter spells across eastern hills.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 20%

Visibility: Becoming moderate or poor in showers, very poor in hill fog with bases quite extensive above 500m, particularly across western districts.

Meteorologist's View

Hill fog most extensive in west, also significant wind chill at height.

Forecast for Saturday 06 Nov 2021

Weather: A few light showers between limited brighter spells at first Saturday. Band of occasionally heavy rain spreading from the west late morning, which clears around mid-afternoon, with only few well scattered showers thereafter.

Maximum wind: Southwest increasing by late morning to mean 35-40mph with gusts reaching 60mph over most exposed ridges and summits. Winds easing as the rainband retreats east late in the day.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 65% becoming less than 10% by late morning, before recovering 70% late in day.

Visibility: Becoming moderate or poor in rain and more sporadically in showers, very poor in hill fog with bases extensive above 500m late morning and early afternoon, particularly across western districts.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 4 Celsius increasing 14 Celsius during the afternoon
At 800m: Plus 5 Celsius decreasing Plus 3 Celsius by late evening
Freezing level: Above all summits
