Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0000 UTC Friday 04 June to 0000 UTC Saturday 05 June 2021

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will gradually displace a humid and potentially thundery airmass to the east of the United Kingdom. Weak fronts will encroach from off the Atlantic but tend to fizzle out under the influence of the ridge.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, veering south 3 or 4, then becoming variable later.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4.

Slight or moderate west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight becoming mainly smooth.

Showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, backing southeasterly for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate for a time near Rattray Head.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, becoming variable at times, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight.

Showers at first.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth.  
Mainly fair.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Westerly veering northerly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later in south.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fog patches and showers, perhaps thundery.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly or northwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in south, becoming variable 3 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or thundery showers, fog patches at first, fair later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable becoming mainly northerly or northeasterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later in east.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or thundery showers, fog patches developing in east.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly or northwesterly, 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in east, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Rain or thundery showers at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwest becoming variable at times, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers, mainly in east.  
Good, occasionally poor in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Mainly west or northwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 2 to 4, becoming southwest 3 to 5 for a time later.  
Mainly moderate in far west, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable, mainly southwest, 2 to 4.  
Moderate west of Lands End, otherwise smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle later in west.  
Good, occasionally poor later in west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel  
24 hour forecast:

Mainly southerly in west, otherwise variable, 3 or 4.  
Moderate until later in west, otherwise slight, but mainly smooth in Bristol Channel.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 to 5 until later in west, otherwise variable 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate in west, smooth or slight in east.  
Occasional rain or drizzle later in west.  
Good, occasionally poor later in west.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable at times in Cardigan Bay, but occasionally 5 at first.  
Slight, occasionally moderate at first, but mainly smooth east of Anglesey.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, 3 to 5.  
Smooth or slight.  
Occasional drizzle later.  
Good, occasionally poor later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less in Liverpool Bay.  
Moderate at first in north and west, otherwise smooth or slight.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable in Liverpool Bay, otherwise south or southwest 2 to 4, occasionally 5 for a time near Mull of Galloway.  
Smooth or slight.  
Occasional drizzle later.  
Good, occasionally poor later.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate until later.  
Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4.  
Mainly slight.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast, 3 to 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or showers in west.  
Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in north.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly, 3 to 5.  
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers later.  
Good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming mainly smooth later in north.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then veering southwest later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in south.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later.  
Moderate, occasionally slight near Cape Wrath.  
Occasional rain or drizzle.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then veering southwest later.  
Moderate.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure centred over Scandinavia will maintain settled conditions over Shetland Waters

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil.

Southeasterly veering southerly later, 3 or 4 occasionally 5 at first in west  
Slight but moderate in the west for a time  
Fog patches  
Moderate or good occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Friday 04 Jun until 0000 UTC on Saturday 05 Jun:

South or southeast 2 or 3 occasionally 4 at first  
Mainly slight  
Fog patches  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

North to northwest 2 to 4, backing northwest to west later.  
Smooth locally slight, with a low swell at first.  
Occasional rain until dawn, perhaps locally heavy.  
Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps locally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest to west 2 to 4, locally variable 1 to 3 by Saturday afternoon.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fine.  
Good or very good.

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
