Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Areas of showery rain, occasionally heavy, will push north and eastwards throughout the period, falling as snow on northern hills. There'll be dry and bright or clear intervals too, however fog could linger in parts of the north. Easterly gales will affect the Northern Isles and a patchy frost is likely overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday and Monday will likely be drier and brighter overall than previous days, though still with showers or longer spells of rain; the showers heaviest and most frequent in the west with possible hail and thunder. Snow will fall over hills and to lower levels at times.
