General Situation

The United Kingdom will continue to lie in an unstable northerly airflow through Saturday. During Sunday, an area of high pressure will move between Scotland and Iceland which will veer the airflow to the east.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North veering east later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, perhaps wintry at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less for a time in north.

Slight or moderate, becoming mainly slight later.

Showers at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

Showers at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate, but mainly smooth in shelter.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North veering east or northeast, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, but mainly smooth in shelter.

Fair.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight in south, moderate in north.

Showers at first, perhaps wintry.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast veering east, 3 to 5, decreasing 2 at times later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Mainly fair.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers at first, perhaps wintry.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

High pressure building to the northwest then northeast of Shetland, veering and easing the flow into Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

North or northeast 4 to 6

Moderate occasionally rough

Showers, risk heavy with hail and thunder in east at first

Good occasionally moderate perhaps poor in east at first

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Sunday 03 Jan until 1200 UTC on Sunday 03 Jan:

Northeast 4 to 6, veering southeast 2 to 4 later

Moderate, occasionally slight later

Showers at first

Mainly good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 to 5, occasionally variable 1 to 3 in the far southeast of the area, generally veering northeasterly overnight and increasing 4 to 6 locally 7 in the northwest of the area.

Slight occasionally smooth, increasing moderate in the northwest of the area tomorrow morning.

Isolated showers, mainly in the south of the area, becoming more widespread overnight, locally prolonged and heavy with hail risk of mist patches near the french coast overnight.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 in the far northwest of the area, locally variable 1 to 3 in the far southeast of the area, generally veering easterly in the evening, then backing northeasterly again later.

In the southeast of the area, slight occasionally smooth in the northwest of the area, moderate increasing rather rough to rough later.

Scattered showers, locally prolonged and heavy with hail risk of mist patches near the french coast overnight.

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
