Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 1200 UTC Saturday 01 October to 1200 UTC Sunday 02 October 2011

#### General Situation

Pressure will remain relatively high across the United Kingdom for the next two days with very slack pressure gradients. However, an active weather front will remain slow moving across northern and northwestern areas, only weakening slowly.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Northeast veering southeast, but variable for a time, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasional moderate in far north.

Occasional rain, becoming fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, veering southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in west.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north.

Mainly fair.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

Variable becoming southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Variable becoming southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.  
Smooth or slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

#### Shetland Isles

##### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will cover Shetland and surrounding waters. A weather front will lie to the southeast on Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Variable, mainly north or northwest 2 to 4.  
Slight to moderate.  
Occasional rain, mainly south.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Sunday 02 Oct until 1200 UTC on Sunday 02 Oct:

Variable, mainly south or southwest 2 to 4.

Slight to moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southeast to east 2 to 4, veering southeast to south 2 to 3 overnight.

Slight.

Fine.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 1 to 3 becoming variable during the afternoon, then southwest guernsey northwards on Monday.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of fog patches in the north on Monday.

Good, possibly locally very poor on Monday.

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
