Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Friday 02 July to 0600 UTC Saturday 03 July 2010

General Situation

A deep area of low pressure to the northwest of the United Kingdom will fill slowly and drift northwards towards Iceland. Its associated cold front will weaken as it continues to move eastwards, finally clearing southeast England on Saturday. A new area of low pressure and associated frontal system will approach western areas Saturday night.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, becoming variable 3 for a time in north.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far northwest.

Occasional rain, then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, but moderate or rough west of Orkney.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

Occasional rain, then fair.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough in far northwest.
Showers, squally at times.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.
Slight or moderate, but rough or very rough in northwest.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North
Channel - (SWW)

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, squally at times.

Good.

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.
Slight or moderate.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southeast, veering southwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.
Slight with shelter, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far west later.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time.
Slight with shelter, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in far west.
Showers, rain later.
Good, becoming moderate later.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Mainly southerly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate north of skye, moderate or rough south of skye.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first.
Moderate north of skye, rough or very rough south of skye.
Showers, rain later.
Good, becoming moderate later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in far west later.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Deep low off northwest Ireland will continue to slowly drift north towards Iceland with various frontal troughs moving across Shetland waters through Friday and Saturday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeast 6 or 7 in the east at first otherwise south or southeast 5 decreasing

4 in the west.
Moderate, occasionally rough in the north.
Rain and mist , clearing to isolated showers later.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Friday 02 Jul until 0600 UTC on Saturday 03 Jul:

South or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Moderate, occasionally rough in the north at first.
Isolated showers.
Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

South 3 to 4, locally variable for a time, gradually veering northwest 3 to 4 this afternoon, backing west later.

Mainly slight.

Occasional rain with mist and a risk of fog patches moving slowly east fair later.

Good, temporarily moderate to very poor near cold front.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to northwest 2 to 3.

Slight with a low swell.

Mainly fair.
