#### General Situation

Areas of low pressure will become slow moving to the southwest of the United Kingdom.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for a time in south.

Moderate or rough, very rough for a time in south.

Snow showers.

Good, occasionally very poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 to 6, occasionally 7, backing southeast after midnight and decreasing 4 to 5, perhaps occasionally 6.

Moderate in the south to rough in the north.

Rain or showers at times.

Moderate to good, locally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 to 5, perhaps occasionally 6, veering south late evening then southwest by Sunday morning decreasing 3 to 5.

Moderate to rather rough with a low swell, becoming slight to moderate Sunday morning.

Rain or showers at times.

Moderate to poor in rain or showers, otherwise good.

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
