

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 02 Jan 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of light rain moving westwards across England and Wales this morning, turning to sleet or perhaps light snow before dying away. Clearer weather over Scotland then spreading to all parts this afternoon and evening, with isolated light showers along North Sea coasts. Overnight outbreaks of rain arriving across the Western and Northern Isles, elsewhere clear with a moderate frost.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday outbreaks of rain across the far north of Scotland, extending to Northern Ireland and the rest of Scotland on Sunday, perhaps preceded by sleet and snow. Otherwise dry with largely cloud free skies, moderate to locally severe frosts overnight.
