General Situation

High pressure close to southern England will maintain generally fine conditions over much of the United Kingdom with mostly light winds. Fresh or strong southwesterly winds will bring some rain or drizzle at times to the northwest.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 at times in north.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in north.

Occasional rain or drizzle, mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north, veering westerly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in north.

Southwesterly 3 or 4, backing southerly 4 or 5 later.
Slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly, veering northwesterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later.

Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in northwest, but decreasing 4 at times in south.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional drizzle, mainly in north.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 in north, veering westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in northwest.

Occasional rain or drizzle, mainly later.

Moderate or good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southwest 5 to 7.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 6 or 7, veering west or southwest 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

South 6 or 7, veering west or southwest 4 or 5 later.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A short-lived ridge of high pressure moves away from Shetland on Tuesday afternoon and a warm front edges north.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly or southwesterly, southeasterly for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate, but rough in north and west.

Fair at first then rain or drizzle, perhaps fog patches later in south.

Good, becoming moderate at times, perhaps very poor later in south.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 03 Sep until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 04 Sep:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 at first in north otherwise southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 in west and north.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight close off east Shetland.

Occasional rain or drizzle, risk of fog patches, soon becoming fair.

Good but moderate, perhaps very poor, at first.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

North 1 to 3, veering northeast to east by dawn, backing northeast to north around midday, increasing 3 to 4 in the afternoon, veering northeast in the evening and decreasing 2 to 3.

Smooth or slight.

Fair or fine some mist patches in the morning risk of sea fog patches in the north later.

Good, locally moderate to poor in mist patches and very poor in any fog patches later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 1 to 3, backing northeast to north in the afternoon, increasing 3 to 4 during the evening.

Smooth or slight.

Risk of sea fog patches mainly in the north and west at first otherwise fair or fine.

Moderate to good, locally very poor in any fog patches at first.

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
