Forecast for Tuesday 05 Mar 2024

**Weather:** A mostly dry and bright day with some sunny spells, after a cold start with some frost giving ice on paths. Chance of a shower for a time in the afternoon, wintry across summits with a build-up of cloud for the afternoon, then clear spells developing in the evening.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m:** 70% at first becoming 90% or more for the afternoon.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Scattered to broken bases around 600m in the morning, mainly near any showers. Cloud bases lifting above summits. Good or very good becoming excellent by the afternoon with good views of distant peaks.

Forecast for Wednesday 06 Mar 2024

**Weather:** Another fine day with plenty of sunshine likely after a cold and misty start. Some valley fog possible until mid-morning. Freshening southeast winds.

**Maximum wind:** Southeast with gusts 25mph across summits.

**Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m:** 80 to 100% for much of the day.

**Low cloud and visibility:** Possible broken to overcast cloud in valleys until mid-morning. Poor or very poor visibility in early morning in valleys, otherwise very good.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Plus 2 degrees Celsius becoming plus 10 degrees Celsius in afternoon.  
**At 600m:** Plus 1 degrees Celsius becoming plus 4 degrees Celsius in afternoon.  
**Freezing level:** Above summits.
