Forecast for Monday 07 Jun 2021

Weather: Any patchy low cloud in Sutherland glens clearing soon after dawn, then a dry bright day. Some fairly extensive high cloud at first but thinning away to allow some stronger sunshine, though some patchy fairweather cloud bubbling up as temperatures rise, with the outside chance of a late afternoon shower.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 95% or more.

Visibility: Very good. Patchy cloud below 450m around dawn.

Forecast for Tuesday 08 Jun 2021

Weather: Cloudy with a little drizzle, brightening up.

Maximum wind: South 20 gusts 30mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 40% rising 80%

Visibility: Moderate or good, but very poor in hill fog caused by cloud based around 500-750m, this lifting to nearer 1100m and becoming more broken in the afternoon.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 9 rising to Plus 18 Celsius.
At 800m: Plus 7 rising to Plus 11 Celsius.
Freezing level: Above the summits.
