### Forecast for Monday 06 Sep 2021

**Weather:** Cloudy with light rain and drizzle overnight. Remaining grey and overcast across much of the area during daylight hours with the cloud well down, light rain or drizzle at times. However, the cloud could lift a little around Assynt and up to Ben Hope.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** Nil to 20%.

**Visibility:** Poor or very poor at any significant height. Moderate or good below the cloud. Extensive or overcast cloud with base 300 to 600m, but below 300m at times, particularly near the west coast.

**Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View**

Significant navigational difficulties expected at height.

**Forecast for Tuesday 07 Sep 2021**

**Weather:** Low cloud, drizzle and mist expected overnight and during the morning. However, the low cloud should gradually lift and break with bright or sunny spells developing in the afternoon. Becoming warm or very warm.

**Maximum wind:** Southwest 15 to 20mph.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** Nil to 20% rising to 40% by midday and 70% by the end of the afternoon. Extensive cloud possible at first with bases well down, 300 to 600m, this lifting and clearing from late morning or early afternoon.

**Visibility:** Poor or very poor in low cloud and mist. Becoming mostly good or very good in the afternoon.

**Temperature:** **Glens:** Plus 12 rising to 22 Celsius  
**At 800m:** Plus 8 to 14 Celsius  
**Freezing level:** Above the summits.
